Description of selection criterion: Tenderers shall, upon request by the contracting authority, submit a tax certificate for VAT and tax certificates issued by a competent body in the tenderer's home country or the country where the tenderer is established. The certificate shall document whether the tenderer has fulfilled his obligations to pay taxes, duties and social security contributions. The certificate must not be older than 6 months calculated from the deadline for submitting a request for participation in the competition or a tender.

Criterion: Financial ratio

Description of selection criterion: 1. Tenderers must have sufficient economic and financial capacity to fulfil the contract. 2. The tenderer's equity shall be positive. Documentation requirement: Tenderers shall present the following documentation if requested by the contracting authority: 1. The tenderer's annual financial statement, annual report and auditor's report for the last three years and recent information (quarterly accounts) that is of importance to the tenderer's fiscal numbers. 2. A brief account of information on economic conditions or losses that are not documented elsewhere and which is required to be documented in accordance with Norwegian and/or international accounting standards. 3. An overview of any recently executed, ongoing or pending tax or public reviews of the tenderer's activities. 4. An overview of any events of significance that has taken place after publication of the last revised annual accounts. If a tenderer has a justifiable reason for not submitting the documentation that the contracting authority has required, he can document his economic and financial capacity by presenting any other document of relevance to the company's fiscal figures/economy. Tenderers shall justify why they cannot submit the documentation that the contracting authority has required.

Description of selection criterion: The tenderer's technical and professional qualifications. Tenderers shall have sufficient experience of a relevant nature and degree of difficulty from equivalent works included in the contract. Documentation requirement: Tenderers shall present the following documentation if requested by the contracting authority: An overview of 3-5 contracts that the tenderer has carried out or executes during the last five years calculated from the tender deadline. The overview shall, cf. the form included in chapter E2, include, among other things, the following for each of the contracts: • Name of the recipient (contracting authority). • Contact person/reference person at the contracting authority with contact data (telephone number and email address) and a statement of the person's role at the contracting authority during the contract. • Date of the delivery. • The contract's value. • What work was carried out by the tenderer, including as the main contractor or sub-contractor, and what work was carried out by sub-contractors. • A description of what the contractual works were about, including relevance to the qualification requirement.

Criterion: Certificates by quality control institutes

Description of selection criterion: Requirements of the tenderer's organisational and legal position. Tenderers shall be a legally established company or consist of a community of tenderers who are legally established companies. The requirement also applies to entities that the tenderer will use. Tenderers shall, upon request from the contracting authority, enclose a certificate from the Register of Business Enterprises or an equivalent certificate for statutory registration in the country where the tenderer or the entities that jointly constitute the tenderer are established, as well as certificates for all supporting entities.

Criterion: References on specified works

Description of selection criterion: Implementation ability The tenderer shall: 1. Have the capacity and ability to handle predicted and unforeseen conditions in the contract. 2. Offer sufficient manpower to carry out the contract. 3. Have technical and professional competence and relevant experience with the key personnel offered for fulfilling the contract. Documentation requirement: Tenderers shall present the following documentation if requested by the contracting authority: 1. An overview of the tenderer's average workforce and the number of employees in the management in the last three years. 2. An overview of the manpower that the tenderer offers to carry out the contract, including an organisation plan for the contract. 3. Criterion: Enrolment in a relevant professional register

Description of selection criterion: Particularly on newly established tenderers A tenderer who is newly established and cannot present all the required documentation must be particularly careful to document and substantiate that they still

have the prerequisites required to fulfil the contract. It is particularly important that such tenderers can document a sufficiently large workforce for the execution of the contract, including technical and professional qualifications. Newly established tenderers emphasise that it is the tenderer's ability as such to carry out the contract that is assessed, not individual persons' competence in isolation. If a newly established tenderer has experience from contracts, the most relevant contracts from which the tenderer has experience must be completed in accordance with the documentation requirements regarding relevant experience. This is even if the contracts are of such a nature that they do not fulfil the specified requirements. The community of suppliers can, if necessary, rely on other entities to fulfil the qualification requirements, see the point on support from other companies to fulfil the qualification requirements. The contracting authority requires that the tenderer who fulfils the requirements for relevant experience shall carry out the services or the building and construction work that requires such qualifications.

Criterion: Security of supply

Description of selection criterion: Support from other entities for fulfilment of the qualification requirements. The tenderer can, if necessary, rely on other companies' capacity to fulfil the requirements for economic and financial capacity and/or the requirements for technical and professional qualifications. Tenderers shall confirm that they fulfil this requirement when submitting their tender. Name: Co2 - Weighting

Description: The builder in this contract will take CO2eq emissions into consideration in addition to price. This will

help reduce the environmental consequences of production and paving of asphalt. See chapter D1.3 for information on any contract points not covered by the CO2eq weighting. The contract will be awarded the tender with the lowest tender sum. Lowest tender sum: The tender sum will be calculated by a mark-up based on the amount of CO2eq emissions. The tenderer with the lowest combined CO2eq emission will not receive any mark-up in the tender sum. The difference in emissions between your tender and the tender with the lowest emissions is calculated for the other tenderers. This difference is priced at 7.5 KR/kg CO2eq. The estimate in the tender sum will thus be the difference given in kg CO2eq multiplied by 7.5 NOK/kg CO2eq. Example point x: 10,000 tons asphalt Supplier A delivers an EPD that shows a discharge of 50 kg CO2eq/tonne of asphalt; i.e. emissions in total 500,000 kg CO2eq. Tenderer A has the lowest emissions and will not receive any mark-up in the competition sum. Supplier B delivers an EPD showing a discharge of 60 kg CO2eq/tonne asphalt; i.e. emissions in total 600,000 kg CO2eq. The difference compared to the lowest emissions is (600,000-500,000) kg/CO2eq and the estimate for tenderer B will be 100,000 kg/CO2eq * 7.50 NOK/kg CO2eq = 750,000 NOK Documentation requirement: EPD shall be delivered in accordance with EN 15804+A2: 2019 and approved by one or several members of the type Established ECO EPD Programme Operator» in eco-platform (i.a. EPD-Norway, Environdec and IBU) for each mass type at the points described in D1.3. This shall include the modules A1-A5 and C1-C3. It will be sufficient to deliver an EPD that includes modules A1-A3 and C1-C3 for each type of mass. In addition a set-up/spreadsheet must be delivered that shows the emissions in the modules A4 and A5 for each point. Contractors must document the prerequisites and measures that are the basis for calculating their EPDs. (e.g. heating medium, use of LTA, reuse, biogenic binder etc.) The additional information form shall be completed and enclosed with the tender. The requested information in the annex "Additional Information FOR EPD Weighting of CO2" can be stated in a separate annex. All requested information shall be provided. The proposal's CO2 contribution shall be production specific; i.e. a separate EPD shall be available from each production location. If there are no separate EPDs, default values can be used for awarding contracts. When default values are used, real and documented values shall be included in the CO2 accounts when the contract is completed. When calculating the bonus/malus, the default values stated in the tender shall be used. Project specific EPDs that refer to approved reference EPDs shall be available at the tender deadline and enclosed with the tender. Requirement to submit EPDs with the tender as stated above is for the points where emission ceilings are set. If EPDs are submitted or budgets that state the value that exceeds the stated roof for CO2eq, it is not assessed as a condition and the tenderer must deal with the ceiling stated in the contract and the provisions on malus.
