Description Description: The Obertraubling – Passau corridor (route 5830) will be completely renovated in the second half of 2026 from June 14th, 2026 to December 12th, 2026.
As part of the general renovation, DB InfraGO AG is replacing, among other things, tracks, switches and overhead line systems in sections. For more flexibility in operation, additional transfer points and switch connections are being created. In order to increase their attractiveness for customers, passenger stations are being modernized. The renovation of engineering structures and the construction of a new railway overpass are also part of the work. Between Plattling and Vilshofen there is an approximately 2 km long section with very unfavorable subsoil conditions (“moorland”). In order to sustainably improve the usability of the route and to ensure long-term operational safety, it is necessary to carry out improvement measures in the substructure or subsurface using the milling-mixed-injection process in total closure.
In addition, a total of 5 new electronic signal boxes will be built and put into operation on the route. The additional transfer points and switch connections as well as the prospective expansion of the ETCS (European Train Control System) require extensive changes to the signaling technology and also the existing electronic signal boxes. This also results in extensive underground cable engineering work and cable laying work on the route.
