To ensure the successful implementation of this project, it is crucial to establish eligibility criteria that guarantee the selection of an experienced provider. The recommended requirements are designed to prioritize technical expertise, regulatory compliance, and long-term service reliability.

a. Completed at least three (3) Command/Operation center ICT projects within the last three (3) years;  
 b. Have a valid PCAB license for Specialty - Communication Facilities, and;  
 c. Must be duly registered as a Data Protection Officer (DPO) or Data Protection Specialist (DPS) with a valid certification from the National Privacy Commission.

**AFTER-SALES & GUARANTEES**  
 a. Hardware Warranty: A comprehensive 2-year warranty on active components, effective upon acceptance, ensuring system reliability.  
 b. Support Services: Technical assistance via phone, email, SMS, and messaging apps, covering operational guidance, maintenance support, and minor issue troubleshooting throughout the warranty period.

c. Preventive Maintenance and System Health Checks: Routine system diagnostics and updates to ensure continued performance and efficiency.  
 d. Periodic System Assessment: Regular evaluations to identify and address potential system inefficiencies, optimization of configurations, software updates and adjustments as required.  
 e. Scalability and Future Integration: The system is designed for future upgrades, including additional emergency response features and IoT-based analytics.

1. The Bidder must have completed a similar project, such as an emergency command center.  
 Additional Requirements for the winning Bidders:

1. The Existing early warning system with mass communication and real-time monitoring shall be integrated into the command center system.
2. The MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF SAN VICENTE, PALAWAN now invites bids for the above Procurement Project. Delivery of the Goods is required by THIRTY (30) CALENDAR DAYS. Bidders should have completed, within TWO (2) YEARS from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II (Instructions to Bidders).
3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184.

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to RA No. 5183.

4. Prospective Bidders may obtain further information from MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF SAN VICENTE, PALAWAN and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below during 8:00 a.m. to 5:00p.m., Monday – Friday.
  5. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested Bidders on FEBRUARY 24, 2026 TO MARCH 16, 2026 from the given address and upon payment of the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents, pursuant to the latest Guidelines issued by the GPPB, in the amount of FIVE THOUSAND PESOS (P5,000.00). The Procuring Entity shall allow the bidder to present its proof of payment for the fees, in person or through electronic means.
  6. The MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF SAN VICENTE, PALAWAN will hold a Pre-Bid Conference on MARCH 04, 2026, 1:30 P.M. at Conference Room, Municipal Government Center, San Vicente, Palawan and/or through video conferencing or webcasting via zoom, which shall be open to prospective bidders.
  7. Bids must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat through manual and online or electronic submission on or before MARCH 16, 2026, 9:15 A.M. Late bids shall not be accepted. Late bids shall not be accepted.
  8. All Bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in ITB Clause 14.
  9. Bid opening shall be on MARCH 16, 2026, 9:30 A.M. at the Conference Room, Municipal Government Center, San Vicente, Palawan given address below and/or via zoom. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend the activity.
  10. FOR ONLINE SUBMISSION, The bidder shall submit simultaneously their bids in two (2) separate folders (1 for technical/eligibility documents and 1 for financial documents) using a two-factor security procedure consisting of an archive format (.zip or .rar) compression and password protection and disclose the password for accessing their respective bid submission only during the actual/virtual bid opening.
- Bidding Documents not in compressed archive folders and are not password-protected, shall be rejected. However, bidding documents not properly compressed and password-protected, as required shall be accepted, provided that the bidder or its duly authorized representative shall acknowledge such condition of the bid as submitted. The BAC shall assume no responsibility for improper compressed or password-protected folder, or for its premature opening.

The MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF SAN VICENTE, PALAWAN reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Sections 35.6 and 41 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
